Registering

Behaviour



Smoking is forbidden in the building. Please use the outside smoking areas.

If you wear a body aid that can be influenced (e.g. pacemaker), please inform your contact person immediately, as electromagnetic fields occur in some areas.

- Observe the access prohibitions and security markings in the various areas.
- Observe barriers and defences.
- Touching machines and equipment is prohibited.

It is prohibited to connect private electronic devices or storage media to the internal network without prior approval.

Please note that the road traffic regulations apply to the outdoor area and that parking is only permitted on the designated areas.



It is forbidden to take photographs in the building or on the premises without permission.



Use handrails on stairs and stairways.

Fire alarm



In the event of an alarm, you will immediately leave the building via the marked escape and rescue routes and proceed to the marked assembly point on the parking lot. Follow your contact person.

Lifts must not be used in the event of an alarm!



Manual fire extinguishers are located in places marked with this symbol.
